Candle Wrap

Supplies:

Candles

Ribbon

Candle Wrap 1 Two 24" pieces of sheer ribbon

Candle Wrap 2 One 24" piece of sheer ribbon

Candle Wrap 1: 3" x 12" applique fabric with fusible web on the back

Glue

Scissors

Wallet Design by Margaret Moorehead (members area VS4 Phase 8)

Rosebuds Design CD by Jenny Haskins (RB42)

Water Soluble Stabilizer

Nylon Organza

Heat Tool

Crystals

Crystal Wand

Embroidery

Hoop one layer of nylon organza between two layers of water soluble stabilizer

Stitch design

Rinse stabilizer out

Use heat tool to remove excess organza

Here we GO!!!!**Candle Wrap with Wallet Design**

Embroider the design

Do NOT Iron when you are finished, you have fusible web on the back of your applique strip and you do NOT want that fabric to be fused to the organza at this point!

We have put the fusible web on the back to deter raveling and to make our fabric easier to handle

Rinse away the stabilizer and remove the excess organza

Apply the crystals to the center design

Insert the ribbon on each side of the center design and be sure they are centered

Apply fray check to the raw edges of the design

NOW you can use your iron....iron the fray check dry using a pressing cloth, and iron your project if needed/desired....remember to be sure you have your ribbons where you want them prior to ironing.

Tie the wrap around your candle

Candle Wrap with Medallions from Rosebud CD

Embroider the designs RB42 from the RoseBud Design CD

Use heat tool to remove excess organza and make into 3 separate medallions

Open buttonholes using the heat tool

I have shown you candles using 2, 3 and 4 medallions

Insert ribbon through the buttonholes being sure that the ribbon does not cover the flowers, space the medallions as desired, and attach to candle using glue to make the medallions lay flat against the candle
